Election Workers Must Take Oath They Are Electors

Enumerators, poll clerks, deputy returning officers and substitute revising officers would have to take oaths that they are qualified electors in Federal ridings in which they act, under amendments to the Canada Elections Act proposed to the Commons elections committee by Nelson Castonguay, chief electoral officer.

The recommendation for oath-taking was made originally by Chief Justice J. C. Mc-Ruer, of the High Court of Justice for Optario following his investigation into irregularities in the Toronto St. Paul Ottawa Music Festival (\$25) riding during the 1957 general election.

The law now requires that these officials be qualified electors in the ridings in which Kiwanis Club (\$300) - Jim they act but does not require that they take an oath to this
